
# Encourage Independence

Remember: Be positive when you talk about school.







### Helping your child learn to read

Talking and listening is the foundation for reading. Talk often with your child.

Play games with the sounds in words.

Recite your child's favourite rhymes.



Make comments about the story "I loved the bit where..."
"My favourite part was...."
Encourage your child to comment "How did you feel about the story?"



'Pretend reading' is valuable— encourage your child's attempts.




