## ***Bullying & Cyber bullying***

The NSW Department of Education defines Bullying and Cyber bullying as follows:

Bullying is repeated verbal, physical, social or psychological behaviour that is harmful and involves the misuse of power by an individual or group towards one or more persons. Cyber bullying refers to bullying through information and communication technologies. Bullying can involve humiliation, domination, intimidation, victimisation and all forms of harassment including that based on sex, race, disability, homosexuality or transgender... Conflict or fights between equals or single incidents are not defined as bullying.

As teachers we are often told of students being bullied but on investigation find that is not the case. We are not happy when students are unkind to each other in any situation and will always follow up student complaints whether they are single incidents or ongoing. The complaining student may not see the teacher investigating the complaint and will rarely be aware of the outcome but teachers do take student complaints seriously.

Please ensure that your child understands that if he/she cannot resolve an incident through discussion with the other party they should report it to a teacher.

## New to School Banking? Get your child started.

To join this savings adventure with School Banking, your child will need a Youthsaver account. If your child doesn't have an existing Youthsaver account, there are three simple ways to open one.

Click on the link to open a Youthsaver account.



### Log on to your CommBank app (if you bank with CommBank)

Head to the menu in the top left corner, select 'Products and offers', then 'Bank accounts' and 'Student and youth accounts', scroll down to Kids and tap 'Open account'.



### Visit any CommBank branch

#### What you'll need

You'll need personal identification for you and your child. You can use a birth certificate, passport, driver licence or citizenship certificate\*. If applying in branch, please bring along your child's birth certificate and/or any applicable Court Order to help us identify you as the parent or legal guardian.

Your child will receive a Dollarsmites deposit wallet to use to make their School Banking deposits when you open a Youthsaver account in branch, or in the mail if opened online.

**Things you should know:** \*The Bank will accept one of the following documents as acceptable identification in its own right. Please note citizenship certificate can only be used as identification in branch. Both certificates of the birth extract issued by an Australian state or territory, birth certificate issued by a foreign government, Note: if either is a language not understood by the person carrying out the verification, the document must be accompanied by an English translation from either a solicitor at the level of Professional Translator or above currently accredited by the National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters Ltd (NAATI) or another accredited translator who holds an equivalent accreditation. NAATI is the Australian Government owned National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters. Where a parent/legal guardian is a signatory to the child's account, they are required to be identified to the acceptable identification standard.

## ***Office***

### **Medication**

Please be advised if you require office staff to give your child their prescribed medication we will need the following:

- A signed and written letter from the parent.
- The letter must clearly state the amount of medication eg: Mls or 1 Tablet.
- Also put the time the child is to take the medication required.

If your child needs on going medication then we will need a healthcare plan from your GP.

## How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

### For iPhone and iPad users:

1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
3. You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install".
4. The app is FREE to download.
5. When installed click "Open"
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.



### For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.



Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

### For Windows 8.1 Phone and Windows 8.1 or 10 device users:

1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

# **Regular School Attendance**

Information for parents and carers of children



**Did you know? If students are late as little as 30 minutes a day, by the end of primary school they will have missed half a year of education.**

Regular attendance at school is fundamental to student learning. Students who attend school regularly are more likely to achieve educational success, and increase their career and life options.

At Mount Druitt Public school we know that morning is the best time for learning. If your child is late then they are missing out on new concepts being introduced and start the day at a disadvantage to the other students.

As a parent/caregiver, you are legally responsible for your child's attendance. Some suggestions to help you are:

1. Have a set bed time and routine. Between 7pm and 8.30pm.
2. Have school bags/lunches/uniforms ready the night before
3. No TV in the morning

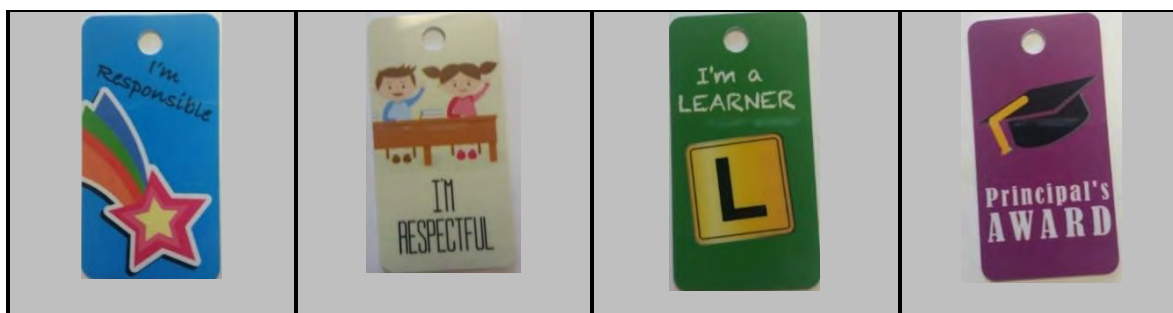

### Does your child catch a school bus? Help them keep it!

As the bus operator that providing your child's school bus services, we're asking for your help getting your child to use their Opal card on every bus trip.

Since the introduction of the School Opal card in 2016, school bus patronage data has significantly dropped. This is not reflected in the number of students actually travelling on our buses for various reasons a large number of students are consistently not using their Opal cards as they should be.

Opal data gathered by tapping on and off is used by transport planners and service schedulers to design the bus network that best serves the community utilising the resources available.

If students don't tap on and off then school bus services will appear underutilised and may be considered for cancellation based on low passenger numbers.

Please help us reinforce the message that tapping on and off every bus journey with an Opal card is essential to travel on the bus. This will ensure school services continue to be planned for the students that use it, providing the journey to school your children depend on.

To help us achieve this, please talk with your child:

- Ask them if they tap on and off the bus with their Opal card.
- If they do, congratulate them for doing the right thing and talk about why it's important.
- If they sometimes don't or never do, ask them why.
  - Are they confused about why they have to? Talk about why it's important, and that every tap tells the bus planners that the bus is needed.
  - Do they forget? Help them find a way to remember, such as getting into the habit of getting their Opal card out as soon as they arrive at the bus stop or bus line.
  - Is their Opal card at the bottom of their bag? Help find a handier place to keep it.
  - Are they influenced by friends or peers that don't tap? Talk about how they like to travel on the bus with their friends and how tapping is what keeps the service running.

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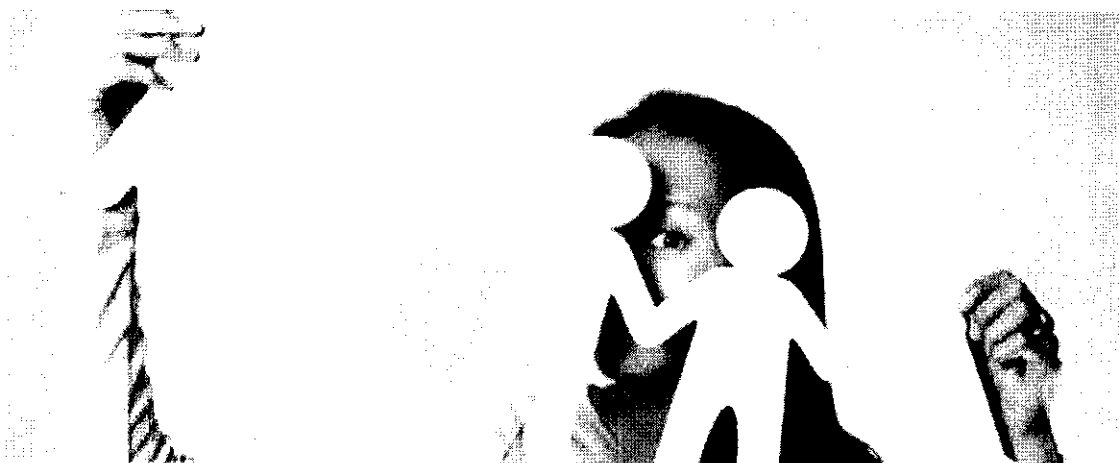

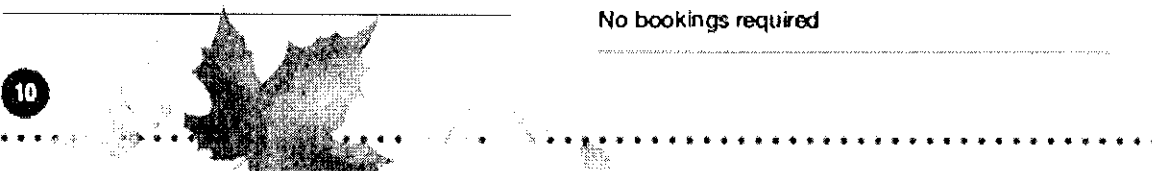

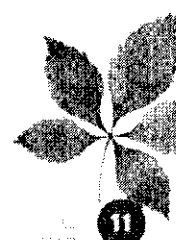
