What happens to the numbers and shapes when I double? What happens when I halve? Make a poster to show your understanding of halves and doubles.

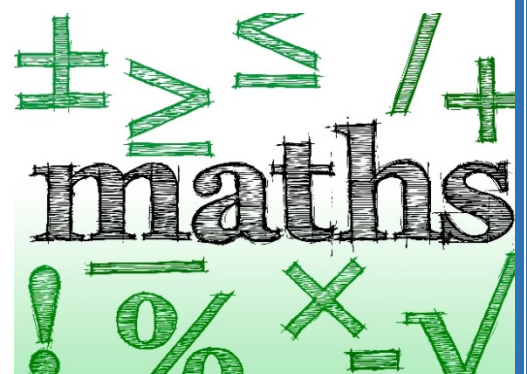
Year 5 and 6 (Stage 3)

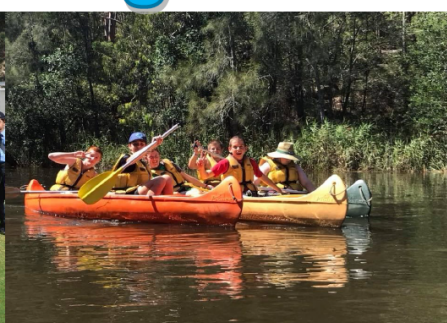
